Kristi gave a presentation on the Village Movement, a concept to assist people on aging in place. There are several villages established in Montgomery County already. The Silver Spring Village currently exists and covers a large area. Kristi is thinking we could implement this concept in our neighborhood. Villages are a local, volunteer-led, grassroots organizations that aim to support community members who choose to age-in-place. They foster social connections through activities and events and coordinate volunteer help at home using neighbor-helping-neighbor model.

There are close to 200 villages in the nation and around fifty in the DC metro region. Each village is unique and reflects the character, interests and needs of the community that creates it. The village leadership decides what it would offer and how it would operate.

Some villages choose an intergenerational model that serves all members of the community. Examples of such villages are the <u>Bannockburn NAN</u>, <u>Village of Takoma Park</u> and <u>Wyngate NHN</u>. Some villages have paid staff in addition to volunteers and charge a membership fee, other Villages are all volunteer and have no fee.

Chris stated that someone is interested in reviving the 50+ Club in the neighborhood. This club provides community members with social connections in the neighborhood.

Chris will check with the BPRA to see if the pavilion could be used to hold a meeting.

The Board suggested that Kristi establish two core groups; one of volunteers or providers (people interested in organizing a village in our community and providing support) and one of people who would use the support.

The Board is willing to host a Zoom meeting to present the idea to the community. Also, if Blocktoberfest is held this year, Kristi could have a table there to discuss the concept with neighbors.
